

# Abstract Submission Guidelines

International Conference of Integrated Intellectual Community (ICONIC) 2026

“Innovation for a Green Economy and Society: Reimagining Indonesia’s Digital and Sustainable Transition”

27<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> August 2026 - München, Germany (Hybrid)

## Guidelines for Submission

### 1. General information

Abstracts should be written in English, including oral presentations and posters.

Abstract should concisely summarize the key contents of the paper. The Abstract length should be 500–800 words, including a brief introduction, the objective of the study, a brief research methodology, results, a brief discussion, a conclusion, and keywords (3-5 words) in a single paragraph. Abstracts that do not meet the formatting requirements will be returned.

Abbreviations of materials or other measured quantities which are of major importance to the abstract’s content, or abbreviations which are familiar to few experts only, must be explained.

Submitted abstracts will undergo a single-blind peer review process, where the reviewers are aware of the authors' identities, but authors remain unaware of the reviewers'. The scientific committee will make the final decision based on the reviewer's recommendations.

### 2. Title

Your abstract should have a concise and descriptive title that reflects the content of your research. The title must not exceed 20 words.

### 3. Authors and Affiliations

Include the full names of all authors and their affiliations (institution, department, city, country) below the abstract.

Authors will be promptly notified about the status of their submissions. Should revisions be necessary or if a submission cannot be accepted, authors will receive detailed feedback. Accepted short contributions will be honored with publication in the conference proceedings, allowing your work to be shared with peers and attendees.

#### **4. Focus of Study**

Choose the relevant focus of study for your abstract from the following options:

##### **A. Circular & Regenerative Economy for Inclusive Value Creation**

The track explores how circular and regenerative economic models, such as green industrial transformation and down streaming and sustainable supply chains, can drive inclusive and resilient value creation in Indonesia's development trajectory. Accepted papers can engage with, but not limited to, how circular strategies can genuinely advance social equity, regional development, and long-term ecological sustainability within Indonesia's broader development agenda. Beyond presenting technological or business planning/solutions on the surface, the track encourages critical reflections on deeper issues such as political economy dynamics, distributional impacts, informal sector integration, and the risks of greenwashing.

##### **B. Green Finance and Just Transition Governance**

This track examines the role of financial systems, public policy, and governance frameworks in enabling a just and accountable green transition. Research can engage with, but not limited to, address Indonesia's sustainable development ambitions while interrogating whether emerging financial architectures genuinely promote justice, inclusiveness, and democratic governance. Contributors are encouraged not only to assess the effectiveness of green financial instruments but also to critically analyze issues of power, accountability, transparency, and social protection- particularly for workers and communities affected by decarbonization.

##### **C. Digital Innovation, AI, and Data for Sustainable Development**

This track focuses on the transformative potential and governance challenges of digital innovation, artificial intelligence, and data systems in advancing sustainable development. Contributions can engage with, but not limited to, examine how digital transformation can support Indonesia's sustainability goals while ensuring ethical governance, institutional accountability, and equitable societal outcomes. While highlighting technological opportunities such as technology, AI, and platform-powered society; smart cities & digital public infrastructure; GovTech/e-government; and data governance, we also encourage research to highlight critical perspectives on algorithmic bias, digital divides, data sovereignty, and platform power.

#### **5. Fields of Study**

We invite students and early career researchers at all academic levels, including Bachelor's, Master's, and PhD to submit abstracts and present their work within the thematic tracks of the conference. Contributions from diverse disciplinary backgrounds are encouraged, including but not limited to:

- A. Environmental science, ecology & biodiversity, climate science, earth & ocean sciences, geography, agricultural & food sciences, forestry & natural resources management, energy sciences
- B. Engineering: Environmental, industrial, renewable energy, and civil & infrastructure engineering
- C. Applied Sciences: Materials science, urban & regional planning, architecture & sustainable design
- D. Economics, Business & Finance: Development studies, industrial organization, public finance, sustainable finance, and impact investment, accounting & ESG reporting, entrepreneurship & innovation, supply chain, and operations management, behavioral science/economics
- E. Social & Political Sciences: Political science, public policy & administration, international relations, sociology, political economy, law, and human geography.
- F. Digital & Data: Computer science, AI & machine Learning, data science, information systems, cybersecurity, digital governance, science & technology studies
- G. Humanities: anthropology, psychology, communication & media studies, ethics & philosophy, and cultural studies

## **6. Type of Presentation**

Specify the preferred type of presentation (e.g., oral presentation, poster presentation) along with your abstract submission. Authors may indicate their preferred thematic track and presentation format (oral or poster) upon submission. These preferences will be considered when preparing the conference programme. However, final allocation remains at the discretion of the Scientific Committee (Guidelines for PowerPoint presentations and posters will be sent to the invited speaker accordingly).

## **7. Permission of Publication**

By submitting an abstract, authors grant permission for the abstract to be published in the book of abstracts.

## **8. Approval of Author(s)**

Ensure that all authors have read and approved the final version of the abstract before submission.

## **9. Process of Abstract Submission**

Abstract submissions will be facilitated solely through the ICONISSA 2026 submission portal. Authors must register as researchers via <https://submission-iconissa.ppijerman.org> and carefully follow the provided instructions for entering author details and abstract content. Submit your abstract via the conference's online submission

portal before the deadline. Ensure that all guidelines are followed to facilitate the review process.

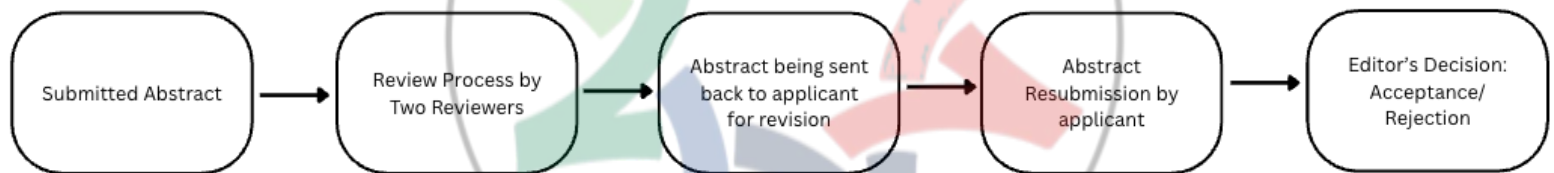
It is important to note that author information and affiliations must be entered separately from the abstract text (title and body). Abstract text can be directly input into the online form or transferred from Word and other text programs using the "Copy&Paste" function.

## 10. Flow of Review Process

Submitted abstracts will undergo a rigorous review process carried out by qualified reviewers, each of whom holds a minimum of active PhD candidacy. Following the review, detailed feedback and comments will be made available directly to the submitter's account via the submission portal, providing an opportunity for revision and resubmission.

Once the revised abstract has been resubmitted, the final decision regarding acceptance — whether as a research paper or poster presentation — will be determined by the editors of the ICONIC 2026 Scientific Committee.
